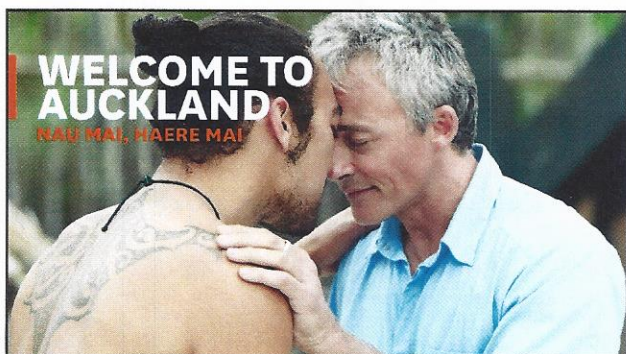

- Waitemata District Health Board runs the largest addiction service in New Zealand with over 200 staff
- The service sees over 15,000 clients/year and over 19,000 treatment episodes/year

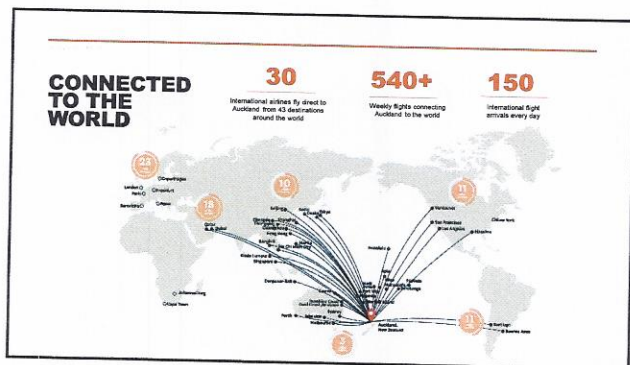
